Dear Students and Parents,

As juniors and seniors (or the parents of ...) you are probably beginning to think about life after high school. There are a lot of decisions to be made and for many of you that will include college. Getting into college means evaluating your high school career and taking the SAT test.

Colleges look at:

- Difficulty level of classes
- Class rank
- Grade point average
- Recommendations
- High school activities
- SAT scores

You can get help now for the SAT. My suggestion is to plan to take the test two times. If you are a junior a good plan is to take the test in December 08 and May 09. If you are a senior and you have not yet taken the SAT you should plan to take the test in December 2008.

Why is it important to do well? Colleges consider the SAT a standard by which they evaluate students from high schools across the country. Some schools believe they can predict how well students will perform in their first year of college based on SAT scores.

Read the brochure and see if our SAT prep class is right for you. You can see from the outline that the material covered is comprehensive. Be sure to take note of the class policy. This class requires consistent attendance. If you expect results, you will need to make participation a priority.
